YEAR 5 HAWSE END RESIDENTIAL 19TH - 21ST MARCH 2025 - FINAL DETAILS

This residential is now fast approaching, please read these final details carefully. We will have a number of meetings with your child in school to go through everything with them.

- Children will need to be in school at **8.50am on Wednesday 19th March**.
- They need to arrive in clothing for the visit e.g. leggings/ tracksuit bottoms, walking boots or trainers, long sleeved t-shirt or thermal, sweatshirt or hoodie and waterproof coat.
- They will need a **packed lunch and refillable drink bottle**, these should be in a **small rucksack** which they can use during the day on the residential. All other equipment should be in a suitcase/ overnight bag.
- We aim to return for 3.20pm on Friday 21st March.
- Please make sure all clothing is suitable for wearing in the outdoors and getting muddy.
- Please refer to the **kit list** which has been emailed today and is on Ghyllside School website. The only change to the original list is that children will need **swimwear** for wearing under a wetsuit.
- Please ensure clothing is **clearly labelled with your child's name** and they recognise all their clothing etc.
- Hawse End has lots of kit that can be borrowed e.g. walking boots and waterproofs if needed.
- Any medication that your child needs must be in the original packaging and handed to their class teacher in a clearly marked envelope. Please label this with your child's name, what the medication is and when they need to take it. If your child uses a blue inhaler this must be put in their day bag.
- **In addition to the form that you completed online, Hawse End also require a consent form. Please complete this and return this by Friday 7th March.**
- Children may want to bring a maximum of £5 to spend in the gift shop. They will not need any other money for this trip.
- Thank you to all those who have paid for the visit in full. If you have not, **outstanding payments need to be paid by Friday 7th March**. Payments can be made by either cash/cheque or online at www.eduspot.co.uk.
