RUNNING CLUB SESSIONS

Tuesday 11th February 2025

Dear Parent/Carer,

What and When

Now that we have a little more daylight we are going to start running club sessions in school. The sessions will be open to children in Y1, Y2, Y3, Y4, Y5 & Y6. Each morning sessions will be run by Mr. Davies, Miss Munday, Mrs. Taylor and Mr. Sillito. The sessions will start with a warm up which will be followed by skills work and then a run (at the children's own pace) over a 1km - 2km loop.

The sessions will run on Tuesday mornings before school. Children need to meet in the hall, changed and good to start, for 8.15am. There will be a sign in register which they must tick to show they are present. We will finish at 8.40am allowing the children 10 minutes to change into school uniform. The sessions will take place every Tuesday morning after half term.

Kit

We will aim to go out whatever the weather. With this in mind, it is essential that your child has the right kit to stay warm and enjoy the session.

- Thermal top/base layer
- Shorts/tights combination depending on how much they feel the cold!
- Additional mid layer (fleece/hoodie) if it's really cold
- Lightweight waterproof
- Hat/Buff and gloves
- Socks
- Shoes with reasonable grip
- Full school uniform including dry underwear, socks and shoes. They must be able to change into a completely dry set of clothes.

If you would like your child to attend the sessions, please complete the permission slip at the bottom of the letter and return it to Mr. Davies by Friday 14.2.25 so I can draw up a register. (If you have not got this letter back to me for the first session – 25.2.25 – don't worry, your child can join in the following week. But I will need a return slip first.)
